Cambridge-based architecture and design firm CambridgeSeven recently made a \$55,000 commitment to the Friends of Cambridge Rindge and Latin School to create an annual scholarship for its science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics program.

The firm recently awarded its first of 11 \$5,000 scholarship to CRLS senior Soliana Yebio, who will be attending University of Massachusetts Lowell in the fall to study biomedical engineering.

To qualify for this scholarship, Yebio had to be the first in her family to attend a four-year college, be a full-time student working towards an undergraduate degree at an accredited college or university and committed to excel in one of the STEAM fields.
